Ninety-five percent (95%) of the buildings in the battle area were heavily damaged [8]. An estimated 150 billion peoso would be needed to rehabilitate the entire city, rebuild damaged artuctures, and restore essential services and 2 billion peoso to rehabilitate the 22 public schools that were destroyed [19]. Aside from these, 47 schools were partially damaged and are currently using temporary spaces for their classes [12]. Private schools in Marawi also appealed to the government for assis- tance in rebuilding structures after the war [27]. The Department of Education (DepEd) is partnering with the Congress of the Philippines for funds to help in the rehabilitation of schools. The government desig-
